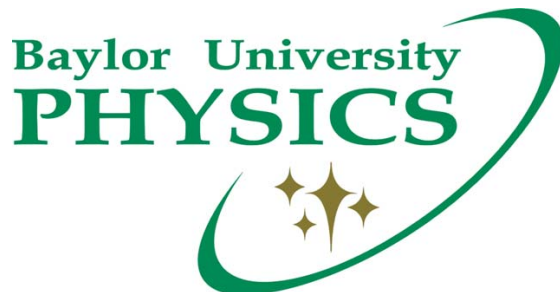

## Tenure-Track Faculty Positions in Physics

The Department of Physics, Baylor University, invites applications for two tenure-track faculty positions at the level of Assistant Professor beginning in August 2009. The Department is seeking to hire one candidate in experimental high energy physics. Exceptional candidates in other research areas will be considered for the second tenure-track position. Current areas of departmental research include elementary particle physics, astrophysics, dusty plasma physics, condensed matter physics, surface physics, nonlinear dynamics, semiconductor physics, experimental atomic and molecular physics, and theoretical early universe cosmology and string/M theory.

Applicants should submit (1) a cover letter, (2) a curriculum vitae including a list of refereed papers published and submitted, (3) a statement of current research interests and pursuits, (4) a statement on teaching interests and philosophy, and (5) a list of three references. Applicants should arrange to have three letters of recommendation sent directly to Chair, Search Committee, Department of Physics, Baylor University, One Bear Place #97316, Waco, Texas 76798-7316. or e-mailed to [nhvsicsiob@baylor.edu](mailto:nhvsicsiob@baylor.edu).

To ensure full consideration for the position, applications should be complete by November 1, 2008. Applications will be accepted until the position is filled.
