The National Science Foundation (NSF) has announced deadlines for their Graduate Research Fellowship Program (GRFP).

The GRFP provides three years of support for graduate study leading to research-based master's or doctoral degrees and is intended for students who are at the early stages of their graduate study. The GRFP invests in graduate education for a cadre of diverse individuals who demonstrate their potential to successfully complete graduate degree programs in disciplines relevant to the mission of the NSF.

Eligibility: applicants must be U.S. citizens or nationals, or permanent resident aliens of the U.S.; must meet certain degree requirements (see solicitation); must meet certain fields of study criterion (see solicitation).

Estimated number of awards: 1,100

Anticipated funding amount: \$40,500, per institution, per award, per year
